 2. **Professional Society Activities 25%**
(National, State and Chapter levels): List offices held, committee assignments, and awards at each level
 3. **Civic and Humanitarian Activities 14%**
List offices held and committee assignments
 4. **Continuing Competence 12%**
List graduate studies (give course and date), short courses and seminars, and papers published (give article, journal and date)
 5. **Engineering Achievements 25%**
Include current position (title, company, or institution), responsibilities (number of subordinates, annual budget), accountability (position, function, nature of challenge), patents applied for, and awards
 6. **Professional Experience 12%**
Include dates of employment, employer/location, description of duties
